WHY DOES THIS MATTER?

- Studies reveal that violent crime increases when a community has a large number of liquor stores that operate for extended business hours.
- The reality in Paterson:
- 42% of ABC investigations in Paterson were for underage sales, and sales of liquor after 10 p.m.
- Between 10 p.m. and 3 a.m. from December 2016 to June 2017, Paterson police were dispatched 512 times for liquor store related incidents.

IT'S TOO EASY TO GET ALCOHOL IN PATERSON

- Paterson has 197 liquor stores
 That's just as many as Newark, which is 3 times bigger than Paterson. State guidelines suggest Paterson should have no more than 67 liquor stores.
- Paterson allows alcohol sales until 3 a.m.
 Many surrounding towns including Newark,
 Jersey City, Clifton, Wayne, Totowa, and others all prohibit liquor sales after 10 p.m.
- Paterson youth are buying alcohol in Paterson
 60% of Paterson youth said they have purchased alcohol from the city's liquor stores.
